From our pioneering work at SCI Phoenix to our innovative Reimagining Reentry Fellowship, Mural Arts is leading the way in reimagining the criminal justice system. Our programs not only provide artistic and professional development opportunities but also cultivate a deeper understanding of the systemic issues that contribute to mass incarceration.

The Guild program, a cornerstone of Mural Arts' reentry efforts, equips returning citizens with essential job skills and provides a pathway to economic stability. The impact extends beyond individual participants, with programs like the Rec Crew that revitalize public spaces and foster a sense of community ownership.

## CITY COUNCIL PRESIDENT KENYATTA JOHNSON

Sarena's dedication extends to her hometown of Philadelphia, where she has supported food access as a Vetri Community Partnership volunteer, and to Los Angeles, where she's contributed to community cleanups and animal rescue. A passionate Mural Arts Board Member, Sarena aims to amplify the organization's impact through storytelling. Currently, Sarena is producing a documentary on fracking in Western Pennsylvania, reflecting her environmental focus.
